



Gas Oven Heating

Be very careful to make sure that the gas is fully off when not in use; there is usually an on/off (aperto/chiuso) lever on the wall near the cooker or under the sink. Never touch any sort of boiler or water heater. You will probably have to use a match or lighter to ignite the stove and oven; being careful will avoid problems.

In some self-lightning stoves, you will need to keep pressing the gas knob for few seconds after the flame has lighted in order for the flame to stay on. Some stoves have a glass top used to cover the burners when not in use. Be careful not to cover the burners with the glass top when the flame is on, as the heat will break the glass.

Remember that gas is very expensive in Italy. If you keep windows open while the heating is on, the apartment will never reach the temperature established by the thermostat, and you will be consuming and paying for more gas than necessary. By keeping windows closed and by turning heat down or off when you are out and during the night you will save a lot of money and help the environment.

The heating of the apartment will be provided by gas heating units, electric stoves or central heating.

Some gas ovens are lit automatically, others must be lit with a match. Be careful and if you have any doubts ask your landlord to show you how it works. Some gas stoves have electric ovens, be careful not to have other heating appliances on at the same time and be sure to turn the oven off after use.

Do not touch your heating unit unless otherwise instructed.



WARNINGS

- If the rent you are paying includes utility (gas) charges please note that only moderate consumption is considered. You will be charged for any excessive use.
- Do not hesitate to turn off your heating unit and to call the Landlord if there are any signs of malfunction (smell of gas, strange noises).
- Heating must not be left on during the night and thermostat temperature must not exceed 18-20°C. (64-68°F). Please note that high temperatures may also damage the heating unit and that you will be responsible for any subsequent repairs. Heating may be turned on from November 1 until April 1 only and for no more than a maximum of 8-10 hours per day.
- Do not obstruct in any way outlet vents or other apertures (the location of your heating unit must always be ventilated).
- Do not sleep in the room where the heating unit is located.
- Do not leave your heating unit on during the night.
- Should you smell gas do not turn on lights or use cigarette lighters. Open windows and turn off the main gas lever.
- When lighting a gas oven make sure that the flame is completely lighted and it stays so. After use make sure that it is properly turned off.
- The water pressure of your gas heating/hot water system must be kept up to 1,00 - 2,00. If the pressure falls below these figures the system will automatically cease to function.
