



## Public Holidays and Festivities / Festività

In Italy, working days, Monday thru Saturday, are called "giorni feriali"; Sundays and holidays are "giorni festivi".

The holidays observed are:

New Year's Day	(Capodanno)	January 1st
Epiphany	(Epifania)	January 6th
Easter Sunday	(Pasqua)	
Easter Monday	(Pasquetta)	
Liberation day	(Festa della Liberazione)	April 25th
Labor Day	(Festa del Lavoro)	May 1st
Republic Day	(Festa della Repubblica)	June 2nd
St. John's Day *	(Festa di San Giovanni)	June 24th
August Holiday	(Ferragosto)	August 15th
All Saint's Day	(Ognissanti)	November 1st
Assumption	(Immacolata)	December 8th
Christmas Day	(Natale)	December 25th
St. Stephen's Day	(Santo Stefano)	December 26th
